# **Next Academic Year**

Dear Parents and Guardians,

On Monday children took part in their first moving up session where most children had the opportunity to meet their teacher for next year and spend some time in their new classroom. Tomorrow morning they will take part in their second session.

As you will be aware we will have less classes in school next year which has enabled us to reallocate some of our classrooms to different year groups. The reason behind these changes is that it enables us to ensure every year group class is situated right next door to their year group partner class(es). This is something we haven't always been able to do up until now but as we have this option available to us we would like to maximise this opportunity as it will make moving between the classes easier and provide greater flexibility.

Therefore next year:-

- Our two current Year Six classes plus Kites classroom will become the Year 6 area.
- Our current Falcons classroom and Woodpeckers classroom (which are next to each other) will become the new Year 5 classrooms.
- Our current Foxes and Badgers (Year 3) classrooms will become the new Year 4 classrooms.
- Our current Hedgehogs, Rabbits and Robins classrooms will become the new Year 2/3 classrooms.
- Our current Wrens (Sensory) room will become the Year 1 classroom.
- Foundation Stage will remain unchanged.
- Owls classroom will be used for sensory circuits and interventions.

Please be aware this relates to the physical classrooms only and class names will remain the same as this year.

At the end of the this term all age/size appropriate furniture, displays and resources will be moved from their current classrooms to their new ones.

# Over the last week at Beechwood......

Foundation Stage have been learning about sea creatures. They have drawn them with wax crayons and lightly painted over the top in water colours. In maths sessions they have been building shapes out of other shapes. In english they have been reading The Rainbow Fish and designing and describing their own fish.

Years 1 & 2 are using the story of St George and the Dragon to learn about and create playscripts in english this week, we are having lots of fun acting it out! In maths, both Year 1 and 2 have moved on to their new unit on position and direction, learning the difference between left and right and learning about quarter and half turns. We all enjoyed meeting our new teachers on Monday and are looking forward to going again on Thursday.

Year 3 have begun their mystery openings unit in english by learning how to write time and setting openings. In maths they have been consolidating their knowledge of addition, subtraction and multiplication. Finally, in computing they learnt how to debug a computer program in Scratch.

Year 4 have completed their work on position and direction in maths. In english they have returned to their learning on biographies and are currently researching their chosen famous character. In geography they have been looking at types of energy use in the UK and learning more about the use of types of renewable energy with a particular focus on wind turbines. In PE they are continuing our development of tennis skills.

Year 5 have enjoyed finishing their geography unit and writing an information text on why Woodley is a great place to live. In maths, the children have been converting units of measurement and the difference between metric and imperial measurements.


