

English

We will begin each day with whole class guided reading, where we focus on our comprehension skills. Our Guided Reading text is Anglo Saxon Boy by Tony Bradman. In writing, we will be retelling the story of the three little pigs using our topic of the Anglo Saxons as the main characters and settings. We will be focusing on the text Tuesday by David Wiesner and will be using this to create diary entries from the perspective of different characters. The children will then create newspaper reports about the mischievous toads. We will be having a BIG focus on handwriting and presentation across all subjects.

French

The children will be continuing their French lessons this term. They will cover weather, school subjects, food, sport and objects within the classroom.

Art and DT

In Art we will be learning about the artist Patrick Hughes and using sketching and monochromatic drawing techniques to create a finished picture.

In DT we will be designing, making and evaluating a slingshot car.

Team: Year 4

History and Geography

In History we will be learning how Britannia changed after the withdrawal of the Romans. They will be exploring how the Anglo-Saxon invasion changed life for those still living in Britain. In Geography, we will be developing our knowledge of the world by learning about longitude, latitude and how it affects climates in different parts of the world.

This term, we will be learning how to play Basketball, Handball, learning new dance techniques and working as a team in OAA (Outdoor Adventurous Activities)

Science

Our first area of study is based on chemistry: States of Matter. This is the fascinating study of what constitutes a solid, liquid or gas, how particles are arranged within these things and how some materials can change state. During Science Week, we will be learning about the science of Time.
