Uniform Policy

Beechwood Primary School children have an excellent reputation for looking smart in their uniform. We are proud of our children and hope that you will help us maintain this high standard as it is important that your child is dressed appropriately and smartly at all times.

Our school uniform:

Boys

Long grey trousers or shorts

White polo shirt **or** short or long-sleeved white shirt with school tie (KS2 only)

Burgundy v-necked jumper with school logo

Dark coloured socks (no trainer socks)

Sensible black shoes which provide a good grip and fasten securely, no open toed sandals

Girls

Grey skirt, trousers or pinafore dress

Summer burgundy and white checked dress

White polo shirt **or** short or long-sleeved white shirt with school tie (KS2 only)

White or black socks (no trainer socks)

Black tights

Sensible black shoes which provide a good grip and fasten securely, no open toed sandals

PE Kit

Burgundy T-shirt with school logo or Beechwood rugby shirt

Plain black shorts

Plain dark tracksuit bottoms

Plain dark sweatshirt, no hoodies, zips or pockets

Trainers (not plimsolls)

Items of school uniform are available to purchase from the PTA shed. Please see reception for forms and opening times.

PE kit should be in school all week and only taken home at the weekend for washing. Please provide a named Beechwood drawstring bag in which your child can keep their PE Kit whilst at School.

Craft activities can be messy and, although we expect children to take reasonable care, you should provide your child, if asked, with an art apron (an old shirt with cut down sleeves would also be suitable).

Shoes should provide a good grip and fasten securely for the sake of the child's safety in the playground. Trainers are NOT acceptable footwear at school other than for outdoor activities.

Jewellery should not be worn in school. If a child has pierced ears, plain gold or silver studs only should be worn. For safety, these have to be removed during PE and can only be removed by the child not a member of staff. We recommend that children who wish to have their ears pierced do so at the beginning of the summer holiday to allow them to heal before

school begins again. Religious jewellery is allowed, within reason. Please contact your class teacher for clarification if unsure.

Extreme hairstyles are not acceptable in school and only natural colours are suitable for the children. Shaved heads or shaved designs on heads are not permitted. Please support us in this by not allowing your child to attend school with inappropriate hairstyles and colours. Hair accessories; slides, scrunchies and bands are to be burgundy or dark in colour and long hair must be tied back at all times.

Make up is not permitted at school at any time.

Children should always be prepared for cold and wet weather. Please make sure that your child has a waterproof and warm clothing at all times plus the correct foot attire in wet and snowy weather.

All children should have the correct school book bag (not a back pack) to keep their reading diaries and books safe.

It is important that ALL of your children's belongings are clearly named. Each term we collect an enormous quantity of un-named items, many of which are almost new. Our lost property box is located in the playground by the hall and is cleared at the end of each term, with any unclaimed items donated to charity.
