Term: Autumn 2024

Welcome back to Beechwood and to Year 2 and 3's Autumn term!

We are looking forward to starting some exciting new units of work!

Please continue to support your child at home and encourage them to read as much as possible. Homework will go out every Friday and is due by the following Wednesday. Reading books will be changed when needed each week, please have books and reading records in each day.

History and Geography

Our topic for the term is 'The Stone Age and rocks,' learning all about this long-lasting prehistoric time period in the UK. We will learn about how they lived and survived, looking closely at the clues they left behind.

The Stone Age will be our theme for the term and will therefore also link in with our work in many other subjects, including learning about rocks and volcanoes in Science and Geography.

Maths

We will be covering the following units:

Place Value

100s, 10s and 1s, comparing and ordering numbers, estimating, counting in multiples.

Addition and Subtraction

Mental strategies, 2 and 3-digit numbers, formal methods, crossing 10s and 100s boundaries, estimating answers.

Art and DT

The children will be given the opportunity to discover and develop a range of techniques. We will make models of Stonehenge and have a go at our own Cave Paintings.

Our investigation will be into how they moved the stones to create Stonehenge.

French

Bonjour! The children will work on their French greetings and basic conversation this term. They will cover numbers and places.

English

reading, starting with The Stolen Spear and The Stone Age: Hunter Gatherers as well as various texts to enrich vocabulary.

Our first unit is instructions, following the text How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth where we will explore imperative verbs, adverbs and time conjunctions. We will then move on to information texts and narratives.

PSHE

We will continue to follow the Jigsaw programme, with the unit 'Being Me in My World.' This will cover rights, responsibilities, choices and consequences.

RE

This term, the children will be learning about the beliefs and festivals of **Hinduism**. We will be thinking about our communities linking this to Diwali celebrations.

Computing

In computing we will be looking at digital devices and how they work.

We will also be looking at online relationships and online reputation.

PE/Games

We have indoor PE on Monday where we will be doing Fitness activities. We have outdoor PE on a Friday, working on Fundamental PE skills.

Science

Our topic this term is **Rocks**. The children will learn to compare and group materials.

We look forward to discovering about fossils as we learn how things that have previously lived can be trapped within rock.
