

Team: Year 1 Term: Autumn 2024



English

This half term the children will start by learning about Robins. We will then be learning all about adjectives and using them to write about the Gruffalo. We will also be completing more fiction units as well as a non-fiction unit about Woodland animals. This term we will focusing on using our phonics knowledge to write sentences including a capital letter, finger spaces and full stops.

Maths

The children are beginning their topic of Place Value. They will be building upon previous learning by exploring numbers to 20. They will be learning how to represent numbers as well as recognising, ordering and counting. Later in this half term the children will be learning to name 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

This half term the children will be learning about animals, including humans. They will be using their topic of 'Woodland Animals', to learn about a variety of animals. They will be naming them, looking at their features and learning about their diet and habitat.

Geography

In Geography the children will be answering the enquiry question: What helps us find our way to school? We will learn about human and physical features in our local area.

History

After half term we will be learning about remembrance and answer the question: Why do we wear poppies to remember?

<u>Art</u>

The children will be printing for harvest time. Then after half term we will be sketching animals. We will be looking at the work of famous artists Lynn Bailey and Mondrian.



PΕ

PE days are Wednesday and Thursday.

In indoor PE the children will be doing gymnastics and after half term, dance.

In outdoor PE they will start with practising their balls skills and fitness sessions in the second half of the term.

RE

In RE this term the children will be learning about Christianity. They will be learning that Christians believe that God created the world, and how we should look after it.

<u>PSHE</u>

The PSHE topic this half term is 'Being me in my World'. The children will be learning about belonging and being part of their class as well as rights and responsibilities.

Music

ICT

The children will be learning how to make a variety of sounds, using instruments and their voices.

In ICT the children will be learning about technology in the world around us. Later on, we will be learning about how to create, store and retrieve content for digital painting.
