# **Parent Information**

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you so much to everyone who took the time to complete our parent survey in July. We are delighted that a high percentage of you feel your child is happy and feels safe in school, and the school offers opportunities for your child to take part in a range of clubs and activities and teaches the children to respect those from different backgrounds, races and religions.

Some parents felt that something we could improve further was communication from the school, and therefore I plan to run a series of information sessions across the year on different aspects of school life at Beechwood. As we are fast approaching a year since we were visited by Ofsted, first and foremost, I feel it would be timely to hold an information session for parents to update you on what we have been focusing on since our inspection and share our priorities for this academic year. This information session will be held at 2.30pm on Tuesday 15th October.

As you may be aware, all teachers are entitled to PPA (planning, preparation and assessment) time each week, which means they spend time outside of the classroom to carry out these tasks. During these times, we always endeavour to ensure your child's class is covered by the same member of staff each week. We are delighted to have Mrs Bolton, Mrs Dahele and Mrs Clays as part of the Beechwood Team to do this. In addition, some teachers have extra responsibilities which may mean they spend more time outside the classroom at different points throughout the year. On these days your child may not be dismissed at the end of the day by their class teacher, but instead by the member of staff covering the class. This is common practice across all schools and is not unique to Beechwood.

Whilst changes are sometimes unavoidable and there will be other times when class teachers may not be in class, timetabled PPA for this term is scheduled as follows:

Monday pm: Year 4

Wednesday am: Year 1 and Foundation Stage, pm: Year 6

Thursday am: Year 5, pm: Year 2/3

# Over the last week at Beechwood......

Foundation Stage have been learning all about houses this week. They have been reading the story 'The Three Little Pigs' and have been drawing the characters and setting and doing a really great job of hearing initial sounds. They have started learning about matching and sorting in maths this week. Thank you for all your donations of junk modelling. They have made some super houses!

Year 1 have been working hard this week to write their own version of 'The Gruffalo'; sequencing the story and then writing the story. They have been writing some super sentences. In maths they have been learning about comparing numbers using the words 'greater than, less than and equal to'. In science the children have been learning about their bodies and naming common body parts. On Wednesdays, the children have been enjoying the dance unit in P.E.; They have explored different moves to the rainy, sunny, frosty and windy weather last week.

Year 2 and 3 have been writing instructions about how to wash a stone age animal using imperative verbs and fronted adverbials. In science, they have been testing the durability of different rocks using acid (vinegar), water and force. In PE the children have been improving their fitness with running and skipping.

Year 4 have worked very hard on their retelling of their story by including similes, alliteration and great sentence starters. In maths they have continued their learning on place value by representing numbers and partitioning flexibly. They have continued learning about the Romans and who is Boudicca. In science they have been looking at teeth and what each of their functions are.

Year 5 have enjoyed writing character descriptions this week in English, using similes, metaphors, fronted adverbials and expanded noun phrases. In music they have begun to compose a piece of music in groups inspired by their chosen planet. In science, they enjoyed using playdough in an experiment to investigate the size of the planets in our solar system.


Year 6 have enjoyed designing their own hexapods this week for their independent non-chronological reports in English and enjoyed getting to know the characters in The Midnight Guardians in reading. In maths, they have been practicing how to multiply 4 digits by 2 digits using the formal method and have developed their reasoning and problem-solving skills. In PSHE they have been thinking about the different opportunities children have across the world and how this differs to how we live. In gymnastics they have been practicing rolls and challenging themselves to connect movements over different apparatus.
