

## Stone Age

### History

This term we will be learning about the Stone Age. We will learn how to create a historical timeline, find out about some of the hunting tools that were used, and we will be doing some Art in order to help us to understand the homes Stone Age people lived in. We will also be doing some cave paintings!

### Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about volcanoes, as well as learning about different Stone Age settlements.

### Art

We will be doing some Stone Age Art, including making some hunting tools, drawing the houses the Stone Age people lived in, and doing some cave painting!

### RE

The children will be learning all about the key beliefs of Sikhism. We will be learning about the main beliefs of Sikhs, as well as learning about some of the special festivals and why they celebrate these.

### PSHCE

This term our learning will be based around relationships. Within this, we will be discussing our own families. We will also consider gender stereotypes, and explore friendship in more detail.

### DT

The children will be working to develop their sewing skills, as the Stone Age people would have had to sew all of their own clothes. We will be practising different stitch types in order to make a Saxon pouch.

### Music

We will be learning about how to work within a group to create a piece of music that reflects a particular mood or feeling.

### ICT

Our computing this term will focus on researching and creating presentations related to our topic.

### PE/Games

All children will be participating in tennis and dance this term. Our outdoor PE will happen on a Thursday afternoon, and our indoor PE will happen on a Friday afternoon.

### English

This term we are learning about fiction writing. As part of our fiction writing, we will be using the book 'Stone Age Boy' to help us become more confident with some grammatical features, such as different sentence types and fronted adverbials. We will also be using the text to give us some ideas in order to write our own Stone Age stories.

### Maths

We use ongoing assessments that the children complete to help us to identify areas that they struggle with and to plan accordingly to address these. Over the next few weeks, we will be revising the written methods we use for multiplication and division. We will also be learning about decimals in the context of money, and we will be doing some work on developing our problem solving and reasoning skills.

### Trips

We have just had our very interesting and informative Stone Age workshop!

### Science

Our topic this term is forces and magnets. The children will be doing some exciting experiments in order to learn about pushes and pulls, magnetic forces, and the strength of magnets.
