



History

The children will be finding out the about the Stone Age and Roman eras. They will be looking at the relationship between invading and settling, in addition to exploring artefacts and everyday life in Roman England.

Geography

This term the children will be using maps to locate the extent of the Roman Empire and plotting their invasion routes. They will be studying Roman and Stone Age settlements and comparing them to modern day villages.

Art

The children will be looking at the characteristic features of Roman design. They will be exploring mosaics and using their creative skills to design their own collages.

RE

The children will be learning about the religion of Christianity exploring their stories, festivals and places of worship.

PSHCE

We'll be thinking about and discussing how we can make our school community a better place and the effects of how we treat those around us.

PE/Games

All children will be participating in gymnastics, while during outside sessions, the children will be learning how to play Hockey.

Trips

We will begin organising trips for the year group soon.

Science

The children will be learning to work scientifically, developing their investigative skills to collect and record data with accuracy. The children will also be engaging with the fascinating topic of Light.



Romans



DT

The children will be following the process of research, design, and production, to create roman shields. They will also be creating their own roman masks.

Music

Year 3s will be learning how to use music to portray and reflect mood. They will also develop their confidence to perform both individually and as a group.

ICT

The children will be learning a wide range of new skills. They will be learning how to use the internet effectively as a search engine and presenting their findings in a PowerPoint presentation. This unit will support their Roman learning.

Maths

All children will be focusing on place value, calculating, number facts, shape and measure. They will also develop their problem solving skills, reading questions carefully and applying their knowledge and understanding effectively.

English

The children will be starting the year by looking at stories set in Roman settings, including Roman myths and legends. They will apply their learning to write their own story set in the Roman times. The children will also focus on non-fiction units, such as information texts and diaries. Each day pupils will read and discuss texts, retrieving information and sharing their ideas and opinions.
