Rules:

1. Entry forms to be returned by Friday 2nd November
2. 30cm minimum height of each Christmas tree
3. One Christmas Tree per entry
4. There are only 25 entries available. Entrants will be treated on a first come first served basis
5. Families can enter a tree for free however, if you would like to use the opportunity to advertise your own business, a fee of £25 must be paid
6. Your property must be within a ½ mile radius of Beechwood Primary School
7. Entry must be displayed at your home
8. Christmas trees must be displayed for the whole 2-week period
9. Christmas tress must be displayed during the hours of 10:00 – 16:00 as a minimum
10. Christmas trees must be decorated in a family friendly manner, should not offend, be obscene or cause distress to those taking part
11. A letter of the alphabet will be assigned to you and must be displayed on your tree
12. A member of the PTA will visit your Christmas tree once it is on display to take a photo. By taking part, you agree for this photo to be used to publicise the trail.
