



Topic Activities Year 1

The activities below support the work of our current topic of 'Around the World in 80 days'.
These activities are designed for your children to spend a long time on. We suggest
completing one activity per week.

Activity	Completed
Design a picture to go on a postcard. This could be your own area or could be from another country.	
Choose a country to research and present information on. This could be through pictures, writing, powerpoint, poster etc.	
Label a map of the UK, including the 4 countries, the capital cities and the surrounding seas.	
Find out about a famous explorer. Where did they explore? What adventures did they have? What transport did they use? Present this information as a fact file.	
Can you plant some seeds ready to learn more about plants when we return?	
Look at pictures made of fruit and vegetables by the artist Guiseppe Arcimboldo and other art made from flowers and plants. Use these to inspire your own picture/artworks from fruit, vegetables, flowers or plants. Photograph your creation.	
Can you learn to count to 10 and say hello and goodbye in a different language?	
The next topic for jigsaw is 'Relationships'. Can you create a family tree? Can you make a poster to show friendship?
