

Back to Butterflies Information

Feel free to share the photographs with your child and discuss any changes in a child friendly manner. Please try to avoid discussing returning back to school negatively in front of your child; we understand that you may have concerns and we respect this, but if you are planning on your child returning to school, keep the conversations around this positive. This will help your child feel safe and secure.

The adults will be wearing a visor at all times. This ensures that your child can still see our faces and allows us to interact with children.

When your child arrives at school, they will be greeted by an adult from Butterflies. We will be wearing aprons and gloves to ensure, that if your child is upset, we can comfort them in safe manner which does not cause them further distress.



Environment

The environment has been stripped back to basics to ensure that it is easy to maintain and clean. The once open planned classroom, is now divided into two classrooms. The partition will remain open as children still need to access the toilets. There is a distinct line taped to the ground to ensure that each bubble does not cross over. Wooden toys and resources have been removed; but don't worry, we still have lots of toys to play with. Your child will find out their room on Monday; it will not change. We will also explain where their lunch boxes and coats will go. The first day back will be all about settling in, establishing expectations and enjoying seeing one another again.



Toilets

The toilets have been colour coordinated to match each bubble. Your child will be encouraged to use the toilets delegated to their bubble. We will monitor this closely.
