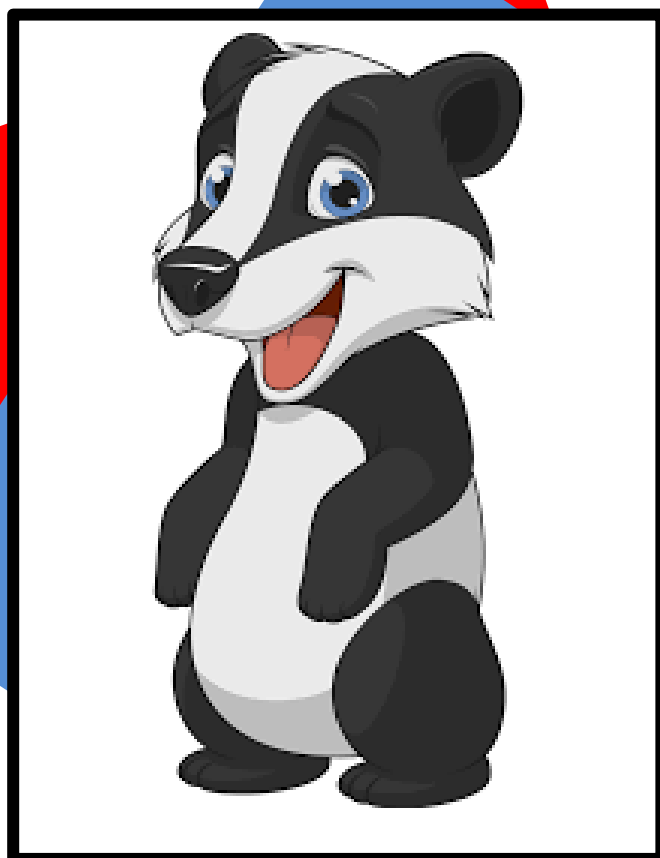


I am moving to...
