Years 5 and 6 have been doing assessments this week. Well done to all the children for working so hard through these. We have continued to learn about space, where we have been looking at rotation and revolution.







A Spanish triathlete has received praise from all around the world for letting his opponent win third place in a race after he took a wrong turn.
