



English

During English this half term we will be exploring lots of different countries as part of our topic 'Around the World in 80 days'. We will be using what we find out and what we have learnt in our Geography lessons to write descriptions about famous landmarks, keep a diary of the places we have travelled to and write postcards or letters to our family or friends.

Maths

At the start of the term, we will be beginning our unit on multiplication and division. We will begin by re-capping counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and then learning how to use these to solve problems. We will be learning about equal groups and how to add and share these. We will then learn about rows and columns when looking at arrays. After that we will move on to our next unit on Fractions; finding half and a quarter.

Science

This half term we will be learning all about plants. We will be planting our own seeds to teach us all about the different parts of a plant and also how to look after them. As part of this topic we will also be learning about the different types of trees. When you are out and about, you might like to see if you can spot them!

Around the World in 80 Days

Geography

In Geography we will be looking closely at our topic and using this to learn about the continents that make up the world. We will learn more about maps and how to use these. We will also be learning about the UK and the 4 countries that make up the UK.



Art

As we visit different countries in our topic we will be learning about and comparing the art of different countries and their artists. For example, we will be having a go at some pointillism when we learn about Aboriginal art and learning about famous works such as the Mona Lisa.

PE/Games

On a Wednesday morning we will be doing PE outside, when we will be taking part in lots of multi-skill games; practising our throwing and catching and teamwork.

RE

In RE this term we will be learning about Shabbat in Judaism. We will be thinking about the big question 'Is Shabbat important to Jewish children?'

PSHE

Our PSHE topic this half term is 'Relationships'. During this topic we learn about the similarities and differences in relationships we have with our friends and our family. We also think about the different people who help us, and how we can be a good friend to ourselves as well as others.

Music

We will be learning how to make a variety of sounds, using instruments and our voices.

ICT

We will be learning how to turn on and off a computer and also how to navigate a simple programme.
