

Over the last week at Beechwood......

Foundation Stage have had a visit from the Big Bad Wolf. The children had lots of questions to ask him and learnt that he is actually a good wolf, who only visited the Three Little Pigs to ask them to play with him! In maths the children have been comparing height and length by building towers and comparing our heights.

Year 1 have been practicing their sentence writing by describing what is inside the witch's house from the story Hansel and Gretel. The children were trying hard to remember their finger spaces! In maths they have learned how to count forwards and backwards using a number line. In science the children are learning about their senses and this week they have focused on the sense of hearing.

Year 2 had a fantastic day on Monday at their Great Fire of London workshop. The children really enjoyed dressing up and having a go at all sorts of activities such as making candles, soaps, quills, clay keyrings, leather bookmarks and lots more things. It was a really brilliant day and everyone came away knowing even more facts about the Great Fire of London.

Year 3 have been researching Mary Anning, a famous palaeontologist in science and also looking at how a computer network works in computing. The children have also been working on cave paintings in art using charcoal and developing their fitness skills in P.E.

Year 4 have had a super week. They are enjoying their new English unit of Instruction texts and they have done lots of great work using number lines to help us with their rounding skills in maths. In history, the children have been learning all about Roman Baths, while in science they have experimented with making solutions from liquids and solids.

Year 5 have started to learn about the features and writing skills needed in information texts in English. In maths, they have been grappling with multi-step word problems. In science, the children have been learning about Geocentric and Heliocentric theories of our universe and they are enjoying dodgeball in P.E.

Year 6 have diligently been working through their practice SATs tests. We have been very impressed with the focus and determination of our Year 6s. In science, the children have learned about the Linnaean Classification system of living things, and have used their research skills to classify various plants, animals and microbes.


