Over the last week at Beechwood......

Foundation Stage have begun learning about the artist "Frank Bowling" and have practised his various art techniques in order to create a large group one off masterpiece. They have enjoyed playing phonics and maths games, learning about repeating patterns and the composition of the number 2. Butterflies have also explored the local area by going on a scavenger hunt in Woodley precinct.

Year 1 have been reading the story of Leaf Man and created our own leaf men using natural resources. After following the journey of Leaf Man in the story, we shared our own ideas of where our leaf men could travel and the things they would see and drew these on a story map. In maths we have been using part whole models to begin our unit on addition and subtraction. In science we have continued our learning about our senses.

Year 2 have been practising their number bonds in maths, to both 10 and 100. In english we have been news reporters, reporting on the events of the great fire of London. We have been watching other news broadcasts and planning how to successfully create our own.

Year 3 have been looking at information texts in english, preparing to write our own all about the Stone Age. In maths we have moved onto column addition and subtraction. In music we have begun to write our own music using music notation and have continued to create Stone Age inspired artwork using stone age painting techniques.

Year 4 have been writing instruction texts and solving addition problems in english and maths. We finished our class text, The Ice Palace, which we've really enjoyed and we have banked lots of interesting language from the final section. We have also been learning about the impact of The Romans on Britain and The Weather Cycle.

Year 5 have enjoyed researching planets this week (linked to our science topic of Space) and are in the process of writing our information texts. In maths, we have investigated how we can work out common multiples of numbers and investigated patterns within these. We have learned about different festivals that are celebrated in France and really enjoyed trying fencing on Monday!


Year 6 have had great fun this week tasting chocolate as part of their learning about Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. In maths we have been practising our multiplication.
