Attendance

Our whole school attendance for the week commencing 17th October 2022 was 92.9% which is disappointingly below our target.

Over the last week at Beechwood......

Foundation Stage have been learning about Diwali . They have made rangoli patterns out of multi coloured rice, 2d shapes and paint. They have made diva lamps out of salt dough and learnt about the story of Rama and Sita and the festival of light. During maths they have looked at the composition of numbers 1,2 and 3.

Year 1 have been learning about Diwali and have been acting out the story of Rama and Sita. In maths the children have been continuing their addition problems. They have started their new history topic and have researched the life of Guy Fawkes.

Year 2 have been learning about King Charles II and writing sentences using conjunctions. In maths they have been subtracting across 10 and using number bonds to subtract from 10. In science the children have been learning about the difference between natural and manmade materials.

Year 3 have started to look at diary entries in English and have developed some super vocabulary to use in their writing. In maths the children have begun to look at multiplication and equal groups, and have already made a fabulous start! In PE the children have started their dance topic, creating movements inspired by factory machinery. Finally, in RE the children have begun to look at the Christmas story.

Year 4 have started their new class text - 'The Butterfly Lion.' They've really enjoyed the start of the story. In English, the children have begun looking at setting descriptions, and in maths they have been working on area. The different Biomes of the world will be explored in Geography lessons this half term, which will be fascinating to explore.

Year 5 have loved designing their own planets and learning about moon phases. In English the children have started learning about persuasion. In R.E. the children have learnt about Sikh weddings.


Year 6 have invented characters for their own chapter in the story Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. They have also invented a new room in the chocolate factory, which will help determine the fate of their new characters. In maths, they have continued our unit on four operations, with a large focus on division.
