# **Attendance**

# Over the last week at Beechwood.....

Foundation Stage have been learning all about Space. They have learnt about some of the planets in our solar system. The children have made rockets, salt dough aliens and "mini me" astronauts. They have also constructed moon buggies out of Duplo. In maths they have looked at the composition of 6 and 7. In literacy they witnessed an alien crash landing and designed and labelled 'Have you seen this alien?' posters.

Year 1 have enjoyed moving around the school for whole school storytime and have enjoyed the other exciting reading opportunities to celebrate National Storytelling Week. They have been writing character descriptions for Peter Rabbit and Mr McGregor in English.

Year 2 have been learning all about Antarctica this week. They have been finding out a little about what life is like there in geography and finding out about the animals of Antarctica during reading lessons. This will help next week when we are writing fact files. In maths we have started our multiplication and division unit, looking at the multiplication symbol.

Year 3 had their pencil cases taken away by Miss Hughes this week and they had to use their best persuasive writing in order to get them back! They have also learnt about the layers of the rainforest and which animals lurk in the trees. In maths they have begun to build their measuring skills and in history they have begun learning more about Francisco de Orellana's expedition along the amazon river.

Year 4 have been working on diary entries in English. In maths they have begun work measuring in kilometres and metres and in reading they have continued with their class novel. In PE they have continued to work on their basketball skills and have been enjoying their swimming on Tuesday mornings.

Year 5 have enjoyed innovating their suspense story this week in English and are looking forward to completing their independent write next week. In maths they are learning about fractions and decimal equivalents and developing their understanding to apply this to calculating percentages. They have enjoyed singing Rock "n" Roll songs in music and learning how to jive in P.E.


