Over the last week at Beechwood.....

Foundation Stage have enjoyed making pancakes to celebrate Shrove Tuesday and have written their own recipes. They have read the story 'Mr Wolf's Pancakes' and have acted out the story. In maths they have been consolidating their knowledge of 6,7 and 8. In PSHE, they have learnt about the importance of exercise for keeping themselves healthy.

Year 1 have started their next English unit on Jemima Puddle-Duck by Beatrix Potter. All the children enjoyed their family learning session and we hope parents did too!

Year 2 have been doing a short poetry unit in English this week based on the poems in the book "Rumble in The Jungle". The children did a super job performing their poetry yesterday and are writing their own poems for the rest of the week. In maths they have been multiplying and dividing by 5.

Year 3 have started their new English unit with some drama, performing the script of the story 'How the Elephant got its Trunk'. In maths they have started looking at fractions and have enjoyed a super fun art day today, creating their own canvas art pieces.

Year 4 have started work on non-chronological reports in English. In maths the children have started a new 3 week unit on fractions. Their new science topic starting this week is sound—how sounds are made and how we hear them, and their indoor P.E. is focusing on dance.

Year 5 have started exploring Tudor biographies in English and are keen to find out more about the era during their history lessons. In maths they have built on their learning from last term (fractions and decimals) and have started developing their understanding of percentages. They are looking forward to programming their Crumble kits in computing and trying golf in P.E.


