

Term: Summer 2023 (first half term)

Religious Education

In RE, we will be exploring the topic of Islam and looking to answer the question:

Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead good lives?

Maths

This half term we will be concentrating on revision topics for our SATs in May. After that, we will be focusing on problem solving and reasoning.

Geography

We will be learning about the structure and importance of mountains; learning about the highest peaks in the world.

Art

This half term we will be looking at Hokusai's series of prints called, *Thirty-six views of Mount Fuji*. We will then learn skills and knowledge surrounding print making.

Computing

We will be learning a range of computing skills on programming, where we will be designing a programme that senses movement, for example a step-counter.

Music

Taking inspiration from electrical circuits and symbols, pupils explore pulse, beat, rhythm and notation, writing and performing their own rhythm grid music. Pupils listen to some of the ways music was created using electricity during the first half of the 20th century.

Science

This term, we will be exploring electricity, through electrical circuits. This topic will continue through until the end of the school year, ending with our own Dragon's Den!

MFL

This half term we will be looking at holidays and celebrations, focussing on retelling simple stories in French.

English

Writing

This term the children will be having a large focus on independent writing. This will allow them to develop their creativity and independence. We have a focus on Mount Everest to link with our overall topic this half term. We will also be focussing on biographies, letters and non-chorological reports about mountains.

PSHE

We will continue to follow the Jigsaw programme. We will be looking at 'Relationships', focussing on how we maintain positive relationships with those around us. On top of this, we will be having a large focus on transitions to secondary school.

PE/Games

In Physical Education, we will be focusing on rounders and tennis.
