# Over the last week at Beechwood......

Foundation Stage have started learning about "Pirates". They have really enjoyed dressing up and making their own pirate accessories . In maths sessions they have learnt about how shapes can be rotated and put together to make other shapes. In literacy they have written sentences about what they can see in their pirate scenes.

Year 1 have travelled by boat to Antarctica. They have been learning lots of interesting facts about this cold continent and the animals that live there. In maths they have started their unit on place value to 100, looking at the numbers on a 100 square and playing snakes and ladders!

Year 2 have been writing about St George and The Dragon this week using interesting vocabulary. In maths they have started their unit on measurement, measuring in both cm and m. They had lots of fun in science planting a bean in a bag, observing how it grows using the hydroponic method.

Year 3 have started their forces and magnets topic in science and have done some exploring with magnets around the classroom, seeing what they stick to and how they act with the objects around them. In English they have begun to look at crime reports, while in maths they have started to look for and identify angles. They are looking forward to their trip to the Ashmolean Museum in Oxford next Tuesday!

Year 4 are starting work on Shape in maths, looking particularly at different types of angles within 2D shapes. In English, they are following a two week genre journey on biographical and autobiographical writing. In geography, they are learning about the physical and human geography of the United Kingdom. In P.E. they have just started to learn tennis. In R.E they are learning about Bar and Bat Mitzvahs. They are now into their last half term as Year 4s and aspiring to achieve at a Year 5 level!

Year 5 have started to explore The Arrival by Shaun Tan and have used this to develop our inference skills and inspire emotive writing that impacts the audience. In maths, they have continued to develop their understanding of calculating with decimals. In computing they have started their new unit, Selection in Quizzes, and will be testing their programming skills throughout the term. They have taken part in athletics in PE and are looking forward to tennis later in the week.


